3.9 Resitting examinations, failure at final attempt

(3) For elective-compulsory or optional modules, the Special Provisions may specify that after an unsuccessful examination attempt, a student's commitment to an elective-compulsory or optional module may be withdrawn upon request to the Examination Committee. This option may only be used once. This does not apply where the module has already been successfully completed.

How to withdraw:

- Please check the conditions for withdrawal from elective-compulsory or optional modules after an unsuccessful examination attempt in the Special Provisions for Assessment Regulations (BBPO) of your degree program.

- Withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing to your program administrator in the Study Organization & Examinations Office, in accordance with the General Provision for Assessment Regulations (BBPO) of your degree program. No specific form is required for your request. A request by email is also acceptable.
- Please note that you may not re-register for the respective elective-compulsory or optional module after withdrawing.
